Serve Team

We have multiple avenues to put your gifts, abilities and availability into practice inside the four walls:

Baptism Team: Help with washing/drying & returning towels, robes & general baptismal prep.

Communion Team: Help with preparing the elements for Communion.

Hospitality Team: Help by providing food such as casseroles/desserts/etc. for events such as Parent Commissioning, Families Count, Senior Breakfast, etc.

Parking Team: Help with parking logistics on Sunday mornings between the 9:00 and 10:45 services.

Mother's Day/Father's Day Team: Help coordinate the special day that is decided on by the Staff to honor the men & women in our church.

Meal Train Team: Help with meal needs within our congregation/community when a family needs a meal provided.

Funeral Team: Be present pre/during/post when we host a funeral at Chelsea. Be willing to set up a hospitality room for the family, receive flowers for the Worship Room, clean up afterwards.

Wednesday Night Dinner Team: Help with prep, serving, clean up after we serve dinner.

Christmas Decor Team: Help with the unloading of Christmas decor from the storage area, placement of the decor throughout the building, clean up at the end of the season.
